The Delaware Institute for Excellence in Early Childhood (DIEEC) invites you to celebrate Children's Book Week, a nationwide literacy initiative sponsored by [Every Child a Reader](#), taking place **November 9–13, 2026**. This year's slogan, Books: Get Curious, celebrates the curiosity, joy, and wonder that help children explore new ideas, learn about the world around them, and develop a lifelong love of reading.

How Can I Celebrate with DIEEC?

We are offering early childhood programs two flexible ways to participate and receive free books for your collection:

1. Host a Guest Reader

Center administrators and family child care educators can request a DIEEC guest reader to visit their program for a special read-aloud. Guest readers will bring several new books for your program to keep and enjoy.

2. Share Your Favorite Read-Aloud

Classroom educators can tell us about a favorite read-aloud book and help inspire other early childhood professionals. The first 100 eligible programs to submit a recommendation will receive a new book by mail to add to their collection. *Limit one book per program.*
